

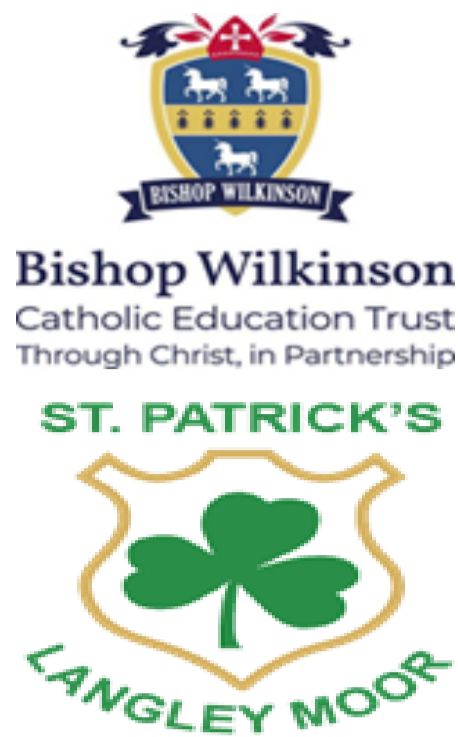


Report a concern about a child

If you have a concern about a child or young person's welfare who lives in County Durham, call **First Contact** on **03000 267 979**. First Contact brings together children's services staff with partners such as Durham Constabulary and health services.

First Contact works to Single Assessment Procedure and Practice Guidance, which can be found on the Durham Safeguarding Children Partnership website (<https://durham-scp.org.uk/>).

If a child is in immediate risk of harm, you MUST ring 999.



Safeguarding & Child Protection

It can be confusing to be able tell the difference between safeguarding and child protection. However, as a school team we must all be aware of the differences.

Safeguarding is what we do as a school to protect individuals (in particular, children and vulnerable adults) from harm such as abuse, neglect, and sexual exploitation. Safeguarding ensures children grow up with the best life chances and that all individuals are given safe and effective care.

Child protection is very similar—however, child protection is what we do as a school to protect children who have already experienced, or are likely to suffer from, abuse, neglect, sexual exploitation, or have otherwise been harmed.

In short terms, **safeguarding is what we do to prevent harm**, while **child protection is the way in which we respond to harm**.
